Agenda Item 9 - Solva Beaches Coastal Award

I appreciate your concerns about the quality of the bathing water at Solva.

To be eligible for one of our Coastal Awards a bathing water classification is required before making an application. There are a couple of ways to get the waters tested, one is to get it recognised as a designated bathing water, the other is to fund a non-designated bathing water programme. I would advise that you speak to Pembrokeshire County Council regarding their legal responsibilities should the waters be designated.

Achieving designated bathing water status can be quite an onerous task in data gathering. You would need to collate data on number of beach users, water-based craft and bath during a bathing season which is from May – September. I would advise discussing an application with Pembrokeshire County Council.

Should the community wish to fund a non- designated sampling programme a minimum of 20 samples taken during the bathing season are required to complete a data set enabling current EU or equivalent classification. The samples can be taken in a single season or over a maximum of 4 years. There is a cost to water collection, transportation and analysis, again I would advise talking to the council and or NRW about the responsibilities regarding this.

To be eligible for a Coast Award the bathing water must have achieved classification of either “Satisfactory” , “ Good” or “ Excellent” depending on which award you would like to apply for. I have attached the criteria for the Green Coast Award and Seaside Award which would be most relevant to the site. In addition to bathing water classification there are other criteria which must be achieved which include safety and services.
