
Our aim - Full fibre in Pembrokeshire

Current statistics for Fibre in Pembrokeshire:

- Only 6.86% of properties in Pembrokeshire enjoy Full Fibre to the property/home (FTTP or FTTH)
- 6.87% have speeds of less than 10mbps
- 2.47% of properties are still only achieving 2mbps download speed
- 88.3% can get speeds up to 30mbps



What is Full Fibre?




Why fibre?



- We need more bandwidth

- Analogue connections due to end in 2025, possibly earlier

Solution - Government vouchers


- Using UK government Gigabit Vouchers
- Topped up by Welsh Government
- Time Limited
- Up to £7000 per business with top up
- Up to £3000 residential with top up
- Mapping the data and working with suppliers
