

Everyone at the surgery will miss his support and joyful personality and are going to miss him terribly, as I'm sure the patients will too.

At the moment we do not have anyone to replace him. In the meantime Dr Sujan Dhaduvai will continue to run the practice single handed.

**Staff shortages** – We continue to experience staff shortages; staffing levels fluctuate from week to week. This affects all areas of the practice, both dispensary and reception. There may be a delay when answering the phonelines and you may be on hold longer than usual. We are grateful for your continued support and patience.

**Appointments** – We continue to triage all our appointments. Our friendly reception team are unable to offer you any Face-to-Face appointments with the Doctor, however they will offer you an appointment for a telephone consultation; following your telephone consultation, if the doctor feels that it is clinically necessary for you to see them, they will then arrange a time for you to attend the practice.

**Covid-19 & Face Masks** – Please note that face masks are still required to be worn in Health and Social Care settings. We ask that all patients attending the practice continue to wear a face mask. Covid is still circulating in the community. Please note that when attending an appointment with the Doctor/Practice Nurse/Phlebotomy, you will be asked some screening questions. We are doing this not only to protect you but also to protect our staff and other clinically vulnerable patients. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE SURGERY IF YOU ARE COVID POSITIVE!

**Repeat Prescriptions** – We recommend that you order your repeat prescription when you have at least 7 days supply remaining. This will allow plenty of time for the surgery to review the request and generate a new prescription, and for our dispensary/Well Pharmacy in St Davids, to obtain all that is needed and safely dispense the prescription. Ordering in this way allows both the Surgery and the Pharmacy to work more effectively and this will be to the benefit of all patients.

**Dispensary & Reception Desk -** Please note that the Dispensary and Reception Desk will be CLOSED for administrative work between the hours of 1pm and 2pm. Telephone lines will remain open for anything that is URGENT, please telephone 01437 721306. There will always be a Doctor on call.


