

## **What can you do to help**

We need as many people as possible to write to the Health Board, the Welsh Government and their local MPS and AMs

The key messages we would like to put across are:

*-To emphasise that the notice period given by Dr Dhaduvai is too short a time within which to allow a properly considered decision to be made and to demand that GP, nursing and clinic services are retained, whilst our proposal and other longer term options are fully explored*

*-That you as local residents support Dr Robertson-Steel's Health and Care hub proposal as presented by the Solva Surgery Working Group*

*-Emphasise that this proposal would ensure the delivery of several initiatives and policies surrounding healthy living and preventative medicine, self care, Future Generations Act 2014 and remote consulting and health monitoring, as well as Pembrokeshire County Council Public Service Board initiatives*

*-Explain that Solva as a community has a wealth of relevant experience and already has a proven track record of delivering innovative community projects and solutions, such as Solva Care and the Solva Community Land Trust and so can be trusted to work in collaboration with the Health Board*

It is also important to include your own personal views and points as we have evidence that Health Board decisions have been reversed on the back of public representation, so please make yourselves heard
