COUNTY COUNCILLER CORNER

Residents cannot fail to have noticed that a new Council Tax bill has dropped through the letter box recently and that there is a 7.5% increase. On the 2nd March, all 60 members of PCC attended the most important meeting of the year to set the budget.

By law Pembrokeshire County Council must set a balanced budget with projected outgoings equal to income. The outgoings are the cost of services provided plus the costs the Council incurs. The income is made up of the grant from Welsh Government, plus rechargeable costs and the Council tax raised from properties in Pembrokeshire. This results in a deficit of approx. £18.9m which is the projected 2023-4 expenditure, approx. £257M minus the projected income and this gap is bridged by a combination of service cuts / efficiencies and council tax rise. Each 1% rise in council tax raises about £700,000. The Council tax collected pays for just over 20% of the total running costs of PCC.

You may well ask why has the Council tax risen by 7.5%? The councillors were offered 2 proposals to vote on. Either the Independent Group proposal of 5.5% or the Cabinet proposal of 7.5%. The lower amount would have required the use of some reserve monies. The higher amount received 33 votes and the lower amount received 27 votes including my vote. This now means that the average band D Council tax bill has gone up by £1.80 per week. Solva Community Council charge has not increased but Dyfed Powys Police charge has gone up by 43p per week for the average home. I hope this explains the process.

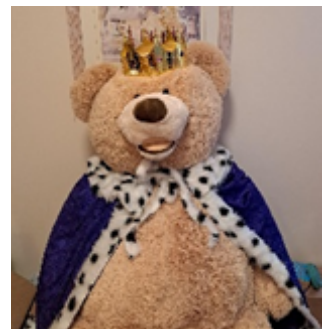
Shalom House Day Centre:

Dr Sujan Dhaduvai's Retirement -Donations – Dr Sujan would like to say a huge thank you to all of you who have dropped off cards and donations and messages of support following her decision to retire. At Dr Sujan's request, any donations that are made will be split between Paul Sartori Hospice at Home and Shalom House.

Repeat Prescription requests and dispensing – As you are aware the dispensing of medication from the Surgery will finish on 31st March 2023. This will mean that from the 15th March we will stop ordering any more stock from our wholesalers and you will see a reduction in availability of prescription medications which can be dispensed by the Surgery. Please bear with us whilst we go through this transition period. You will be asked to take your paper prescription to a chemist.

All patients will have received a letter from Hywel Dda Health Board explaining how you get your medication from 1st April 2023.

If you have regular medication (called Repeat medication) you will still need to order this from the Surgery and the staff will produce a prescription which will need to be signed by the GP. You can either collect the signed prescription from the Surgery and then take it to any Community Pharmacy yourself for them to dispense it for you, or you can ask for all your signed prescriptions to be sent directly to a Community Pharmacy of your choice which may be more convenient. If you are prescribed a medication as a one-off, or not on a regular basis you can do the same.

To order your Repeat prescription

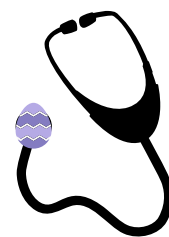
Please contact the Surgery to order your prescription 7-10 days before your medication is required.

Order your prescription via the same methods, either by phoning the repeat prescription line on 01437 720644, online or post your repeat slip directly to the surgery.

You can collect your prescription or nominate your chosen Pharmacy

Collect your prescription from the Surgery and take it yourself to a Community Pharmacy. Or ask the Surgery to send your prescriptions to one of the Pharmacies below that has a collection service and they will have the medication ready for you to pick-up 7-10 days after your order. Some Community Pharmacies offer home delivery of your medication. This is not an NHS service, is subject to delivery radius and delivery charges may apply.

If you want all of your prescriptions to go to one of the Community Pharmacies that offer this collection service, you can tell one of the reception team at the Surgery and they will note this in your records so that every prescription goes there directly, this means that you won't need to collect your prescription from the Surgery.

The Health Board is working with the Surgery and local Community Pharmacies to make this transition as easy as possible for patients, however we need your help in doing this by ensuring that you order any repeat medication 7-10 days in advance of when you need it, so you don't run out of any medication.
