# **COUNCILLORS CORNER**

This month we start with some very good news.

For some time due to budget restraints the toilets on the harbour at Solva have been under threat of closure due to withdrawal of financial support from PCC. The cost is just over £12000 per year but all the revenue from parking is kept by the National Park. If Pembrokeshire County Council kept the revenue from the parking, then that would have funded the toilets. It is great to hear that the National Park has agreed to fund the toilets for the next 2 years so fingers crossed for 2025 they will keep doing so

Another budget cut that has been implemented is the withdrawal of grey bags. Whilst there will still be a collection of residual waste limited to 3 bags every 3 weeks, householders will now be required to supply their own black bags of approx 60 litre size for this collection. The cost saving is about £300,000 per year with distribution accounting for a large proportion.

As Councillors in County Hall, we are being presented with increasing amounts of information in respect of the budget for 2024-5 and how much cost savings need to be made. As usual costs for education and social care swallow up about 70% of the budget. Every year some members of the public, especially on social media are quite vocal about how the books could be balanced. For starters there are both statutory (essential required by law) services such as education, social care and refuse collection and non statutory services such as grass cutting leisure services and public toilets. The essential services cannot be removed but can only be cut back to a bare minimum level. The non essential services can be removed or cut back but care needs to be taken that these services are not cut back so far that they become ineffective. I think we need to be warned that over the last few years all the easy or even medium options have been used up and April 2024 may see some very savage cuts. For these reasons, Solva residents will note my concerns at County Hall in respect of any major project that goes or could go over budget and require extra funds in excess of grant money allocated. This Council needs to concentrate on the basics whilst we are in this financial storm. The full working group met to hear the Claire George, Service Delivery Manager, Hywel Dda University Health Board (HDUHB), talk about community health services in Pembrokeshire and how capacity is being built around GPs. The emphasis of the Health Board's strategy is to build cooperation and partnership working across the sectors to provide a seamless and integrated service at the locality level, and one which includes wellbeing as the corner stone. The model is very much in keeping with what the community would like to see in Solva and the Peninsula but the consensus was that faster progress was needed. 

<u>Practice Nurse Team</u> – We are delighted to welcome Val Clay to our nursing team. Val started at Solva at the beginning of September and joins Rebecca Bowie and Anne Davies. You may have already met Holly Mowlam who originally started working in reception but has now joined the nursing team as a Health Care Assistant. She will be sitting in and shadowing the Practice Nurses whilst she undertakes her Level 3 Health Care Diploma training. Both Holly and Mair Beynon will continue to hold phlebotomy clinics throughout the week.

The Practice Administration Team include - Jayne Williams, Practice Manager. Catherine Andrew, Helen Phillips, Mair Beynon, Moira Reynolds and Nicola Williams. The team make appointments for patients to see the doctors and nurses, take requests for home visits, process repeat medication requests and acute medication queries. They liaise between the patients and the doctors, community teams and third-party sector. The team can signpost patients, advise and make patients feel safe and listened to while arranging the most appropriate next step.

<u>Covid Booster Vaccinations</u> — We are now able to offer patients that are registered at the practice, their Covid Booster vaccination. The clinics will be held on a Thursday. If you are over 65 years of age or under 65 years of age (\*with an underlying health condition). Please check with our reception team if you're unsure or you can visit the Public Health website: https://phw.nhs.wales

**Flu Clinics** – Having a yearly flu vaccine is one of the best ways to protect against catching and spreading flu. Please don't wait to be called for your flu vaccination, please ring the surgery to book your appointment. If you are over 65 years of age or under 65 years of age with an underlying health condition, you will be eligible. Contact a member of the reception team to make an appointment.

<u>The Nasal Flu vaccination</u> is also being offered to all children who are aged 2 or 3 years old (i.e. date of birth from 1 September 2019 and to 31st August 2021) – please contact the surgery to make an appointment.

<u>Shingles Vaccination</u> – Have you turned 70 but not yet 80 years of age? If so you are eligible for your shingles vaccination. Please telephone the reception team on 01437 721306 to book an appointment.



# THE FLU VACCINATION PROGRAMME
