Solva Community Council – AGM Highlights

Solva Community Council held its Annual General Meeting on Wednesday, 14th May 2025, at the Memorial Hall. All community councillors were in attendance, along with a small number of residents.

During the meeting, residents were invited to review and contribute to the Council's Vision Statement. This forms an important part of shaping the Council's plans, budget, and activities going forward — ensuring that community voices are reflected in our priorities for 2025 and beyond.

Traffic concerns were also raised by a resident, with key issues including:

- Speeding through the village
- A suggestion to deploy a GoSafe speed enforcement van as soon as possible
- A request for traffic calming measures, similar to those in Newport
- Concerns about narrow pavements for wheelchair users and those who rely on Walking aids
- A request for a new traffic mirror at the end of Glanhafen to improve visibility for vehicles joining the main road
- The use of electric scooters

There was also a request for more regular updates and improved communication from the Council regarding ongoing projects

Council elections took place during the AGM, and we're pleased to announce:

- Cllr Gareth Chapman was elected as Chair
- Cllr Josh Phillips was elected as Vice Chair
